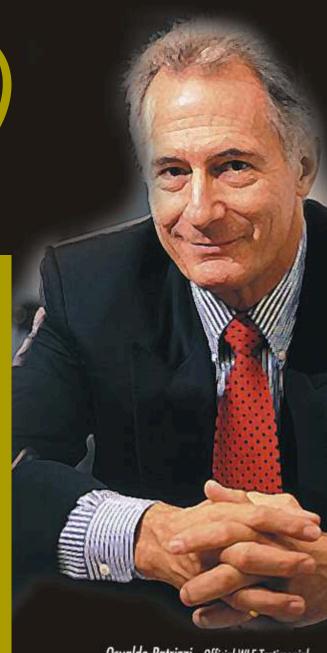

The exhibition will be open to the general public from 4:00 to 7:00 p.m. (one-day and three-day admission tickets will be sold).

Characteristics

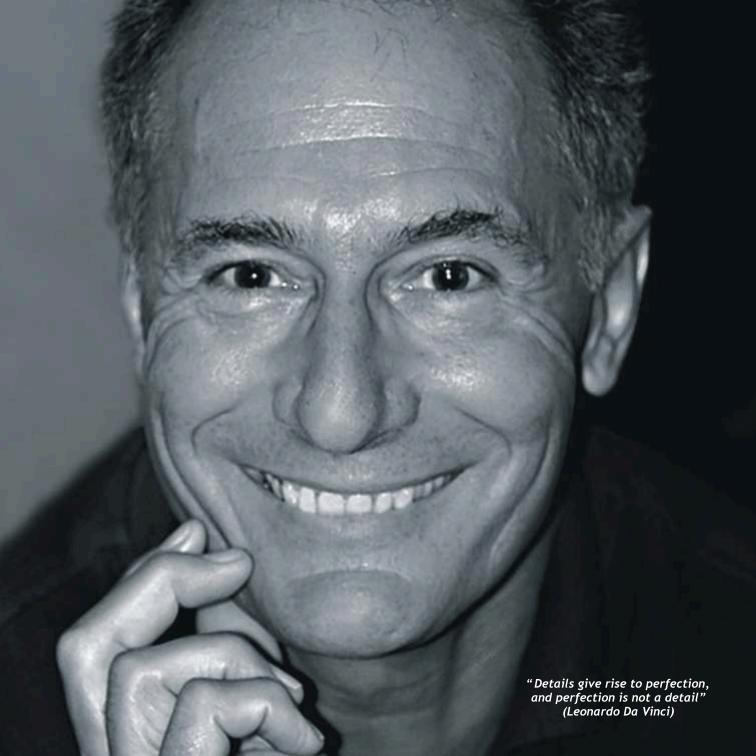
- An auction area organized by Osvaldo Patrizzi, in cooperation with Fair Management: the most eagerly awaited and covered event of the exhibition on a national and international level.

Testimonials

- Osvaldo Patrizzi, C.E.O. of PATRIZZI & Co AUCTIONEERS, began his career in watches at thirteen when he worked for a watch and clock restorer in Milan. In 1974, he established an auction house devoted to watches, clocks, and art objects. He is a world-renowned expert in watches, and his firm Antiquorum has been one of the world's leading auction houses for timepieces since 1987. Osvaldo Patrizzi has always been a pioneer in his sector: he was the first to present wristwatches in an auction in 1980, and he was also the first to introduce themed events, starting with "The Art of Patek Philippe" auction in 1989. Osvaldo Patrizzi also launched the collector's watch market in Asia, where he held the first auction in Hong Kong in 1979. He was the first to have a website and online auctions, and also the first to have developed a system of interactive online bidding simultaneously and in real time with classic auctions. He is responsible for selling over 75% of all the watches valued at one million dollars and up. He also created a "Grading System" that is the most reliable tool today for helping collectors, with just the catalogue at hand, to evaluate the condition of a particular watch. He has written numerous articles about his passion for watches and he is the author of many books on the world's most prestigious watch brands, which have become references for collectors and museums alike. In 2000, American journalists included Osvaldo Patrizzi in its list of the top twenty most influential figures of the 20th century in the field of watchmaking. In April 2008, he has opened the new auction house Patrizzi & Co. with bases in Geneva, Milan, New York and Hong Kong.
- Kathryn Bonanno Patrizzi, Osvaldo Patrizzi's wife, a gemologist since 1978 specializing in colored stones, Art Deco and 1940's jewelry, has recently been elected Vice President of AGA, from which she received the title of Accredited Senior Gemologist. She has obtained certification in several specialties and is one of the few gemologists in the world to have received the F.G.A. diploma with distinction. She received the P.G. diploma and is member of ICA and GIA.

She has worked as a gemologist in Asia, Europe, and the USA. She has been living and working in New York City since 1991.
